### **“PPG completes the acquisition of the AkzoNobel North American architectural coatings business”**

- Announcement date: Monday, April 1, 2013
- PPG Industries (NYSE: PPG) has completed its acquisition of the North American architectural coatings business of Akzo Nobel N.V., Amsterdam, in a deal valued at \$1.05 billion.
- Assets acquired include: all AkzoNobel North American architectural coatings manufacturing and distribution facilities, paint stores, product lines and employees related to the production, sale and distribution of architectural coatings in the United States, Canada and the Caribbean.
- Leading brands acquired include are GLIDDEN(R), FLOOD(R), LIQUID NAILS(R), SICO(R) and CIL(R).
- PPG also now licenses the following brands: DULUX(R), DEVOE(R) architectural coatings, and SIKKENS(R) architectural wood products.
- The former AkzoNobel North American architectural coatings business had total 2011 revenues of about \$1.5 billion.
- In addition to its approximately 400 company-owned stores, PPG has added approximately 600 through this acquisition, including:
  - ~ 300 in the United States
  - ~ 240 in Canada
  - ~ 50 in the Caribbean
- PPG has acquired about 4,700 people and 23 manufacturing and distribution facilities locations across North America from AkzoNobel. Major manufacturing sites include:
  - Oakwood, Georgia
  - Huron, Ohio
  - Carrollton, Texas
  - Temple, Texas
  - Toronto, Ontario, Canada
  - Beauport, Quebec, Canada
  - Vancouver, B.C., Canada
  - Carolina, Puerto Rico
